- a) Monitoring and reporting of Adverse Drug Reactions (ADRs) related to Ayurvedic drugs and therapies.
- b) Ensuring proper documentation and submission of ADR reports to the designated Pharmacovigilance centres/PvPI.
- c) Creating awareness among faculty, clinicians, interns, and students regarding pharmacovigilance.
- d) Organizing workshops, CMEs, and training programs on pharmacovigilance and ADR reporting.
- e) Encouraging voluntary reporting of suspected ADRs from clinical departments.
- f) Maintaining confidentiality and ethical standards in ADR data handling.
- g) Preparing and submitting periodic reports to the Competent Authority.

Instructions for the Committee:

- a) The Chairperson shall convene meetings of the Pharmacovigilance Committee at least once every quarter.
- b) Minutes of the meetings shall be properly recorded and submitted to the undersigned for record.
- c) This Committee shall come into effect from //2026 and will remain operational for the academic year 2025-2026.
