### **Roles & Responsibilities of the Committee:**

The Discipline & Anti-Ragging Committee shall take the following actions to ensure a safe and conducive learning environment:

#### **1. Dissemination of Ethical Guidelines**

- Ensuring that all students, faculty, and staff are well-informed about the institutional Code of Conduct and Anti-Ragging policies.
- Displaying anti-ragging warnings on the institution's website, prospectus, and student handbooks.
- Collecting anti-ragging undertakings from students and parents (as per UGC & NCISM directives).

#### **2. Vigilance & Monitoring**

- Conducting regular inspections in classrooms, hostels, canteens, and other common areas to prevent ragging and disciplinary issues.
- Establishing an anonymous grievance redressal mechanism for students to report incidents without fear of retaliation.
- Installing CCTV cameras at key locations for continuous surveillance.

#### **3. Rapid Response Mechanism**

- Establishing a 24/7 helpline number and an email-based complaint system for reporting ragging incidents.

- Ensuring immediate investigation and resolution of complaints, with necessary support for victims.

#### **4. Awareness & Sensitization Programs**

- Organizing seminars, workshops, and awareness drives to educate students about the legal consequences of ragging.
- Conducting orientation programs for newly admitted students, introducing them to the anti-ragging guidelines.
- Inviting external experts, law enforcement officials, and alumni to share their insights on campus safety.

#### **5. Strengthening Communication & Reporting**

- Maintaining detailed records of all incidents, complaints, and actions taken.
- Submitting periodic reports to the Competent Authority and ensuring compliance with NCISM/UGC guidelines.
- Coordinating with student councils and faculty members to proactively address student concerns.

#### **6. Counseling & Student Support**

- Collaborating with the Counseling & Mentoring Department to offer emotional and psychological support to students facing harassment or ragging.
- Conducting one-on-one counseling sessions for students involved in disciplinary violations to help them integrate into the institutional culture.

#### **7. Stringent Action & Compliance**

- Recommending strict disciplinary actions, including fines, suspension, or expulsion, in accordance with institutional and legal frameworks.
- Ensuring adherence to NCISM, UGC, and Ministry of Education guidelines on anti-ragging measures.

### **Instructions for the Committee:**

#### **1. Monthly Meetings:**

- The Chairperson shall convene monthly meetings to review and enhance the committee's effectiveness.
- Minutes of Meetings (MoM) shall be documented and submitted to the undersigned for record-keeping.

#### **2. Annual Calendar:**

- The committee shall prepare an annual calendar of anti-ragging and disciplinary activities for timely execution.

#### **3. Surprise Inspections:**

- Periodic surprise inspections of hostels, canteens, and other sensitive areas shall be conducted.

#### **4. Reporting Mechanism:**


- Any reported incidents of ragging shall be immediately investigated, and an Action Taken Report (ATR) shall be submitted to the Competent Authority.
- Severe cases of ragging shall be reported to law enforcement agencies for legal action.

#### **5. Implementation of NCISM/UGC Guidelines:**

- The committee shall ensure full compliance with the UGC Anti-Ragging Regulations, 2009 (including 2nd & 3rd Amendments).
- Any updates or advisories from NCISM and UGC regarding anti-ragging measures shall be promptly implemented.
- This Discipline & Anti-Ragging Committee shall come into effect from 19th December 2025 and will remain operational for the academic year 2025-2026.
